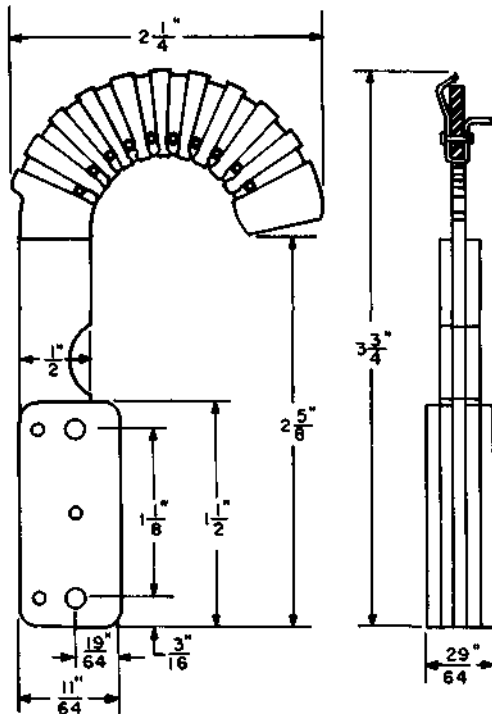
1. GENERAL

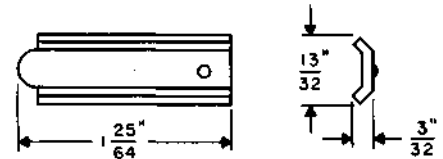

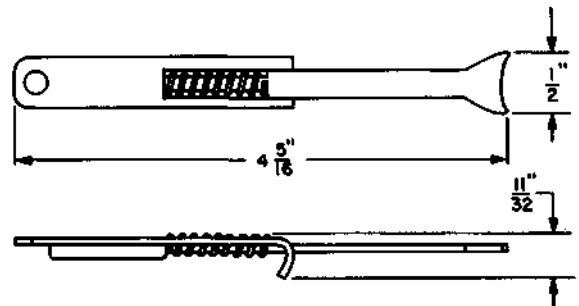
Bank busying tools. Replaces the AECo H-23366 busying tool.
The 370A tool is for use with a W10A cord and a 240D plug for test purposes on 100-point, step-by-step banks.
The 370B tool is for use with a W10A cord and a 240D plug for test purposes on 200-point, step-by-step banks.

Make-busy tool. For use on 197- and 198-type switches.

560A



Make-busy tool. For grounding the outside springs of 245-, 254-, 263- and 264-type relays by shorting the springs to the cover ground. On 245- and 254-type relays, the tool clamps on the spring. On 263- and 264-type relays, the tool clamps on the insulator which forces the tool prongs against the spring. Replaces the 530A tool. For use on 245-, 254-, 263- and 264-type relays.
