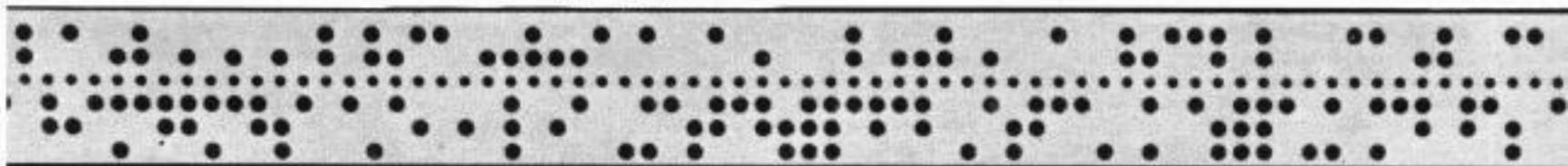


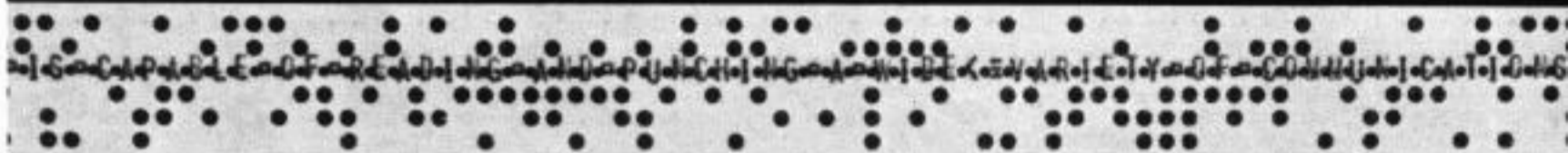

Fully punched, without printing, 5 level



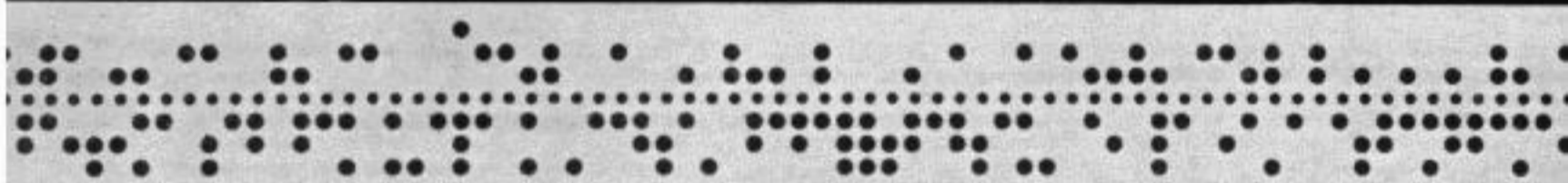
Fully punched, with printing, 5 level



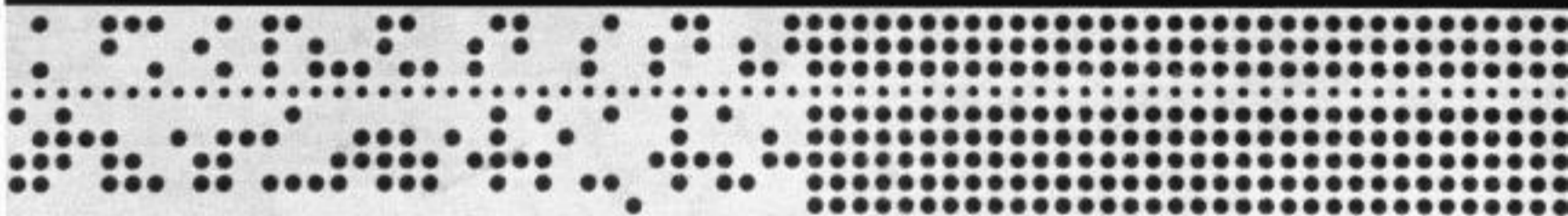
Partially punched, without printing, 5 level
